SCOPE OF WORK

Klepper, Hahn & Hyatt did the structural design of a new academic building, the Stockade Building, for Schenectady County Community College. As part of this initiative, the college requested that the campus courtyard be redesigned to create a sense of entrance to the heart of the campus. The courtyard is the centerpiece and connector between Elston Hall, the Begley Building and the new Stockade Building.

The main feature of the courtyard is a circular plaza with brick and stone seating walls. The plaza is connected to the parking lot and buildings with stairs, ramps and concrete walkways accented with concrete pavers.

A brick planter, accented with a decorative stone boulder, creates a focal point for the plaza. The boulder was specifically selected by the college administration.

The color choices for the brick, coping, walkways, pavers and railings unify all three buildings, which are constructed of various colors of brick. The new Quad now serves as the main entrance to the campus.
