SCOPE OF WORK

Klepper, Hahn & Hyatt was responsible for the structural design of this five-story, 120,000-square-foot new court house building in Syracuse, New York.

The structural design included reinforced concrete footings, piers, walls and slabs, along with structural steel moment frames. Steel floor beams and girders are composite with the concrete floor slabs.

The architectural wall system for the main building includes a unique concrete block veneer with light gauge metal stud backup, along with some glass block panels. The entry area wall system is constructed of glass curtain wall and glass block. This building won a design and installation award from the American Concrete Institute for excellence in the use of masonry materials.
